The Artful Pen Ask Arty...



Dear Arty,

I just signed up for an Oil Painting class specializing in landscapes. It was suggested that I buy a "fan" paintbrush. This certainly does not look like a traditional paintbrush. What do you think? Sincerely, Frederick

Dear Frederick,

How exciting! The fan brush is, as named, a fan shaped paintbrush with a thin layer of bristles generally used for blending and feathering colors.

This brush style is excellent for creating trees and bushes in landscape art with oils. Tapping the brush separates and flares the bristles which adds texture and a totally unique look to a painting. Forcefully dabbing the brush will evoke an even different look. This paintbrush is great for giving an evergreen tree it's fuzzy and ragged edge. Use a free flow, twisty movement to give your trees a realistic and natural look with great texture and detail. Every time you use this brush, you can do different things. Some artists even choose to cut some of the bristles out of their fan brush in a ragged pattern to make a very rough scraggly mark.

Fan, like many paintbrushes, come in a variety of materials. When painting in oil, be sure to buy those that have natural hogs, sable, fitch or squirrel hair. Best to stay away from synthetics.

Experiment with your fan brush to get the desired look of your composition. As your fan brush gets used over time you will see how it produces different looks. Don't get rid of it, cherish this!

Always, remember to take good care of your paint brushes and they'll reward you by lasting a good long time.
