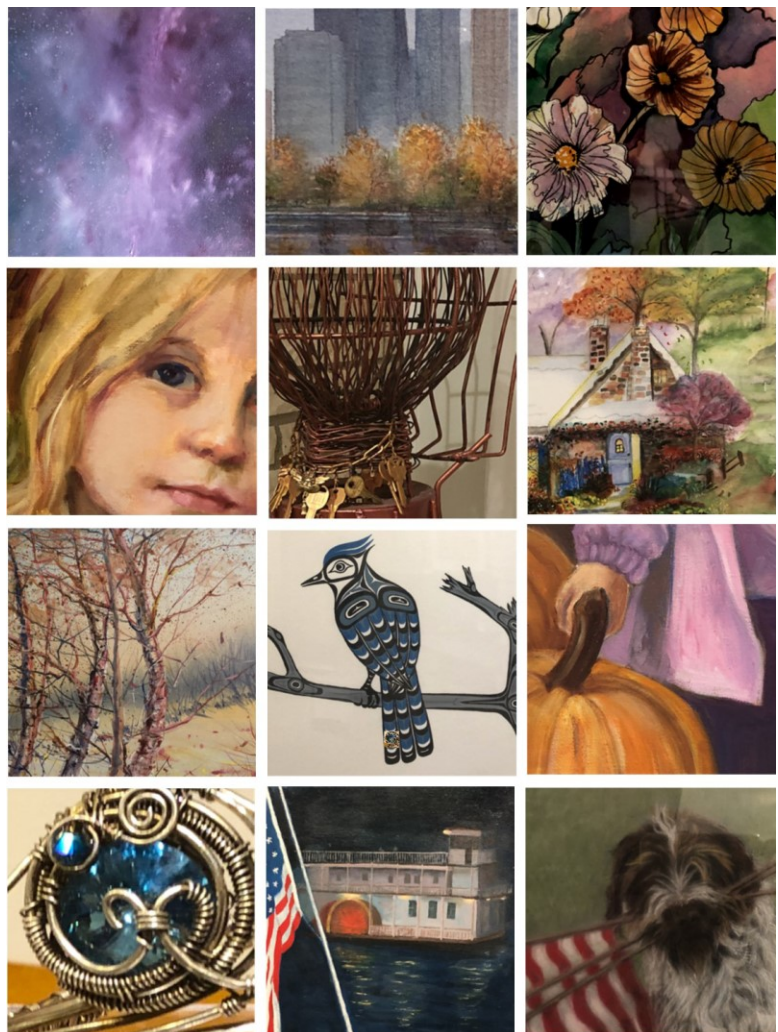

Live, Clothed Model Session March 18th, Thursday 6:00-8:30 pm.

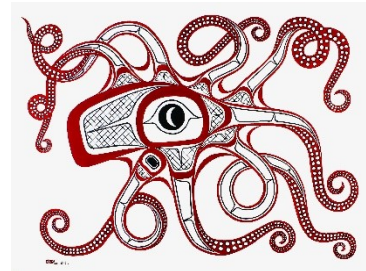

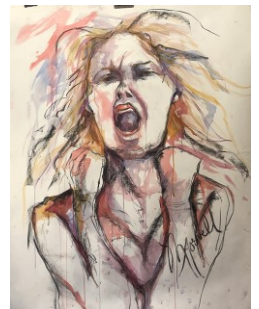

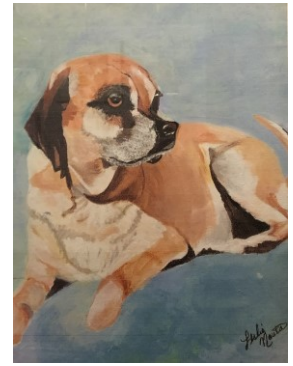
Short Creative Writings
