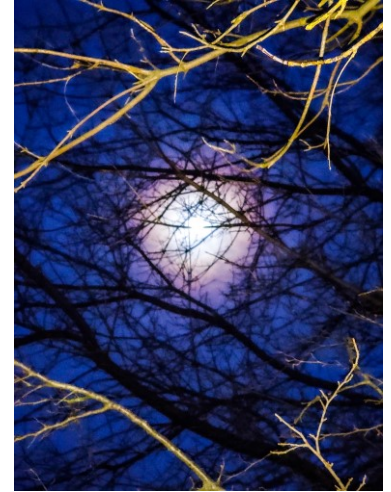

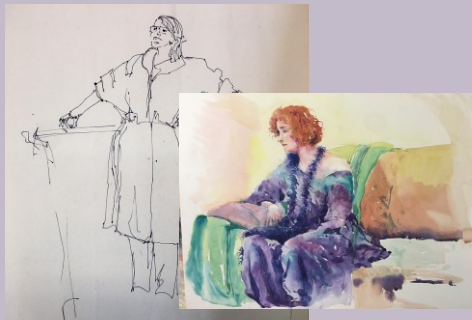
## Pastel Class
