


January Featured Artist, Author Ron Daiss


Ron will do a reading at the reception on January 22nd 2-5 pm. Some of his books are for sale at the gallery.

Ron Daiss, off Nome, has dogsledded with an Eskimo hunting seals along the Bering Sea Ice; experienced the Good Friday Earthquake in Anchorage; was a state enforcement officer of commercial salmon fishing laws on Kodiak Island; trapped furs with an Indian mentor in Alaska's interior; prospected for placer gold in Kantisha. In the West, he has trained horses and guided hunters in Montana; prospected for desert gold in Arizona. His activities, North and West have been told in nine periodicals and five books.
