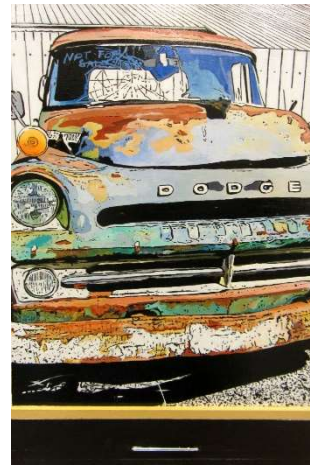

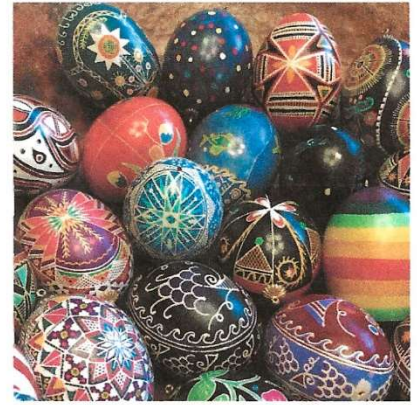
Ukrainian Egg Decorating Event

VERSE ABOUT WESTERN ARTIST

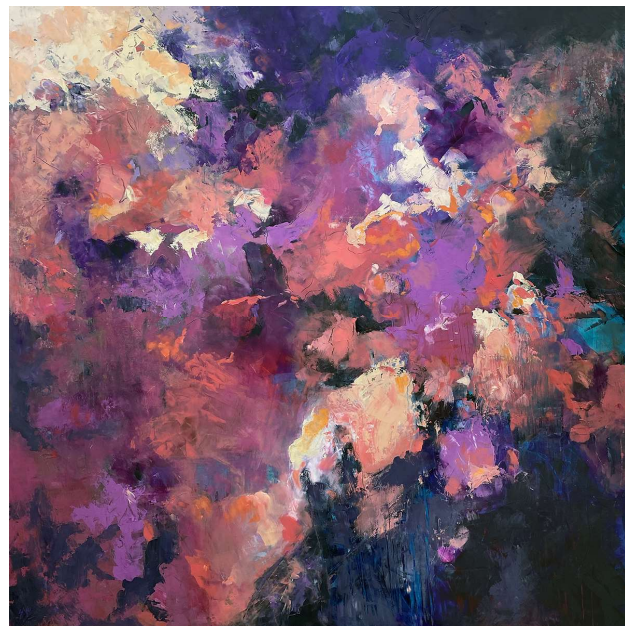

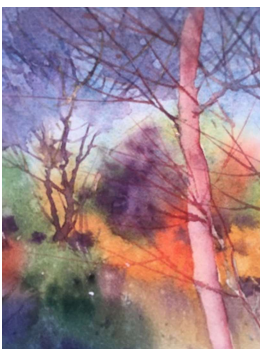

Drawing Basics for Teens and Adults

Teacher: **Barbara Wagner**

Thursday nights: 6:30 – 9:00 for 4 weeks

May 5th, 12th, 26th, and June 2nd

Over 4 weeks, we will learn freehand 2-D line drawing, from both live set-ups and photos, and then create 3-D form through shading and values. Subject matter will be still life and landscape, and work in both pencil and charcoal.

Students should bring a 2B pencil, a charcoal pencil, kneaded eraser, and a 9x12 (or larger) sketch pad.

Course fee: \$100 to be paid at the first class.



Barbara Wagner has been teaching drawing, as well as acrylic and oil painting in Lake County for over 20 years. She is a firm believer that anyone can learn this skill and you don't need "natural talent". She taught both adult and teen groups in her private studio and at the College of Lake County. She currently lives on a small farm

in Antioch with horses, goats, dogs, cats, and one amazing husband.

Debbie Moretti's Workshop – Make your own marbled silk scarf

Debbie Moretti brings the ancient art of marbling into the 21st century; wooden trays are filled with "magic" water as acrylic paint is dropped on the top of the surface, and the artist can use a rake, comb, stylus, or nothing at all to make a unique design.

Designs can be strong and bold or traditional and tightly patterned, paired with handpicked colors. The final piece is a true reflection the artist. The bonus is that the process of marbling is almost as fun as it is to create!

Join us for a marbling experience on Saturday, May 21st, 10:00am – 2:30pm. You will get the opportunity to make a six-foot silk scarf and watch other participants make their masterpiece. Cost of workshop is \$50.

Mother's Day is May 8th – buy a spot at the workshop for the mother in your life or stop by the gallery for a scarf created by the artist.
