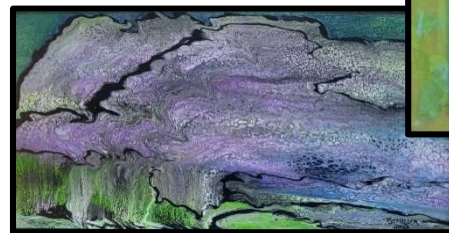

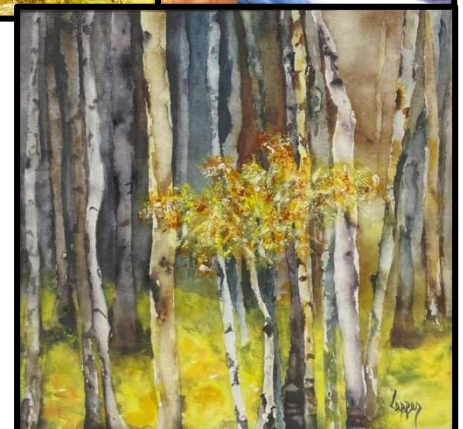


### Featured Artist: Beth Lepper

Beth Lepper's "formal training" began at the age of 11 years, when she was enrolled in a two week summer camp. Each day was focused on a fundamental, e.g., color wheel, figure drawing, perspective, shading, contour drawing and even plein air drawing.

Her subsequent art instruction was after she was married, when she enrolled in Tole Painting for a few years. Her instructor also taught still life and some landscapes in oils. After retiring, she took classes in colored pencil, mixed media, and a beginner watercolor class. She joined the Lake County Watercolor Guild, and participated in various 3-day workshops with visiting professional artists, as well as being a regular student of David R. Becker.

Beth approaches each painting with the only expectation of a new learning experience. "If it turns out well,... then that is a bonus!"
