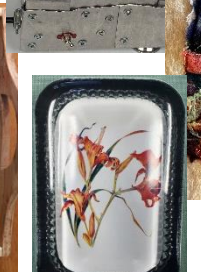

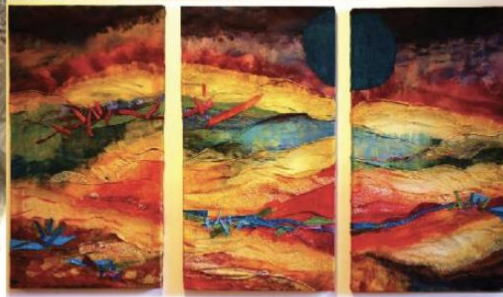

She is owner of a vibrant fiber arts studio, Esther's Place, located about an hour from Chicago, providing an inspiring retreat for fiber enthusiasts. Her blend of vintage inspiration, romantic styling, strong color theory and uninhibited originality make her work and teaching a trademark for creativity in the fiber arts community.
