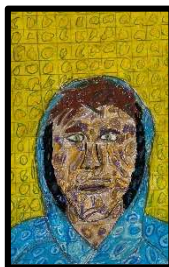
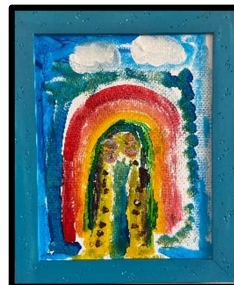

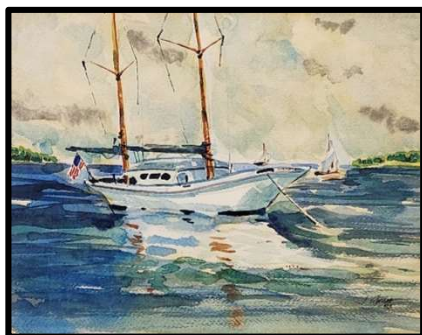


About 6 years ago, she discovered pastels and fell in love with this medium, especially for painting animals. She often works on two works simultaneously – one in oil and one in pastel.
