













Featured Artist: Cindy Trombino



Wire and Lampworked Glass Sculpture by Cynthia Trombino and Logan Ghormley

Cindy's thoughts: "My inspiration has always been nature but more recently my inspiration also includes my son's work. My son, Logan Ghormley, was a glass blowing artist who also created wire and glass sculptures. Logan passed away in 2018. For years, I watched him develop his passion and create his art. Logan was attuned to the patterns in nature and opened my eyes to look for them. I now create wire and glass sculptures and jewelry using the wire techniques and fused dichroic glass he used. Sometimes I create collaborative pieces adding his glass, broken glass pieces, or ones I have fused. Altered photographs are also created with an emphasis on patterns and nature. Logan's art includes furnace blown glass, some into wire, lampworking, and mixed media. He started when he was 15 years old. Logan stated that "the shine of glass reminded him of the shining sunstones and jelly opals that he collected with his family in Oregon when he was young". Logan said that "the shine of glass reminds me of the rocks, but glass blowing allows me to manipulate shapes and patterns."
