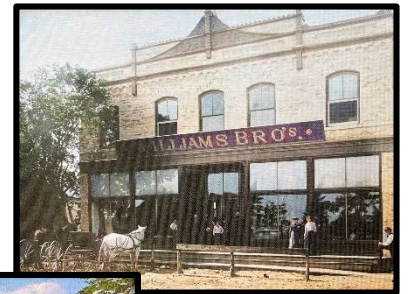

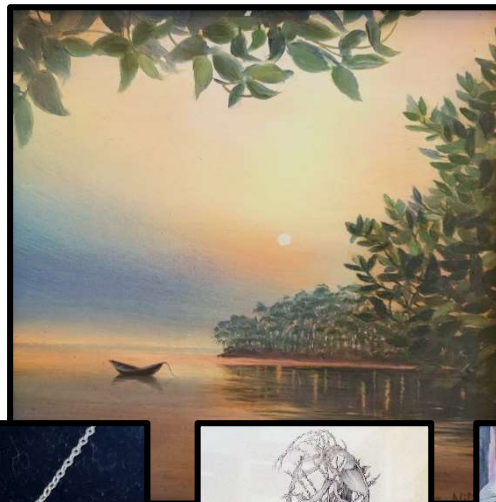

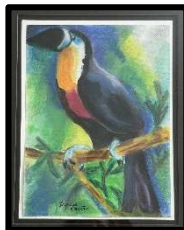


Pastel Art Workshops
