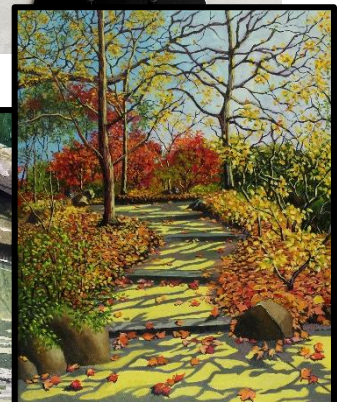
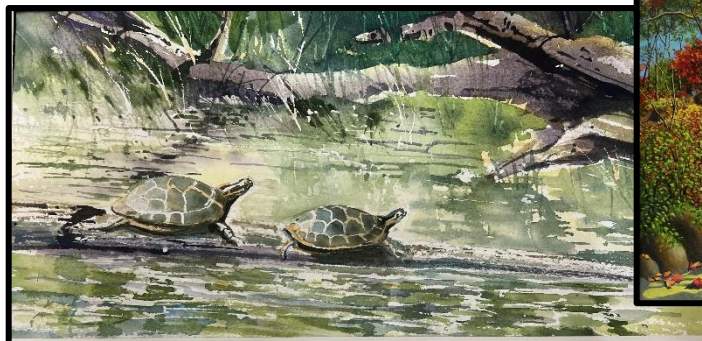
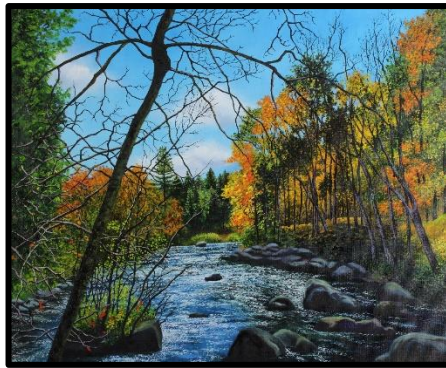

Pastel Landscape Workshop

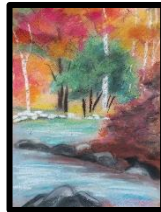
Ages 12-Adult
