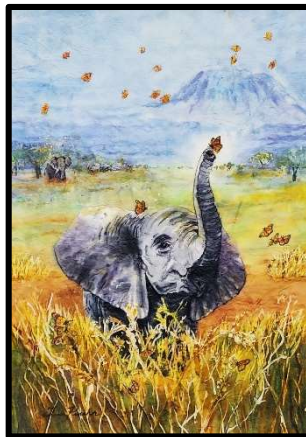

FEATURED ARTIST: MISSY SHAW



Missy Shaw discovered pottery about two years ago after heartbreak. From the first moment she began "playing with clay" she knew she had found her passion.

Soon afterwards, Missy's father surprised her when he shared that pottery was in her blood through his mother, her Grama Nancy "Piscitello" Shaw. Missy's great-grandparents, emigrated from Sicily to Pennsylvania in the early 1900's. Generations back, Rosario Piscitello founded

Piscitello Ceramics in Sicily, in 1683. Over three hundred years later, Antonio Piscitello, and his family, are still producing beautiful tiles, plates and other works of art.



"My family history inspires me! reveals Missy. "When I sit down at my wheel with a ball of clay, I have a general idea of what I am looking to create, but the clay ultimately tells me what it wants to be. All pottery pieces are food, microwave and dishwasher safe."

Terrazzo Trinket Trays

Learn how to create a terrazzo-style trinket tray with concrete!

Students will work with artist-grade white concrete; adding liquid and dry pigments for color.

You will learn how to create terrazzo chips, mix and color the concrete, prepare a mold for pouring, sand the cured piece until smooth, and apply sealer.

*NOTE: It is recommended that the tray be allowed to cure for 14 days before using.

Lecture: Using Your Photos for Reference and Getting a Good Composition with Michael Schmitt,

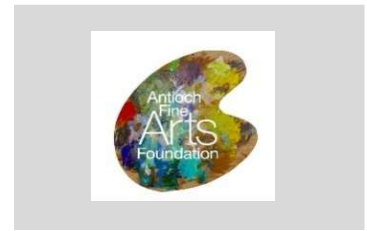
Thursday, November 14th, 7:00 – 8:00 pm
