## **Terrazzo Trinket Trays**

(Ages 10 - Adult) (Children accompanied by an Adult) by Tiffani Williams Thursday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 - 8:00 pm



Learn how to create a

terrazzo-style trinket tray with concrete!

Students will work with artist-grade white concrete; adding liquid and dry pigments for color.

You will learn how to create terrazzo chips, mix and color the concrete, prepare a mold for pouring, sand the cured piece until smooth, and apply sealer.

\*NOTE: It is recommended that the tray be allowed to cure for 14 days before using.

Cost: \$60/person (supplies included)

\*Please wear clothes for messy projects/ masks provided for dust sensitivity.
