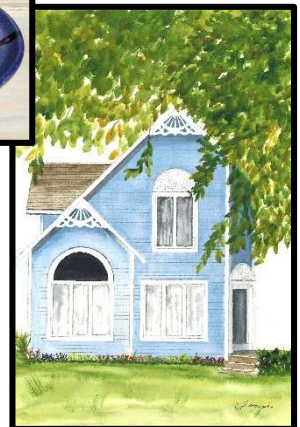
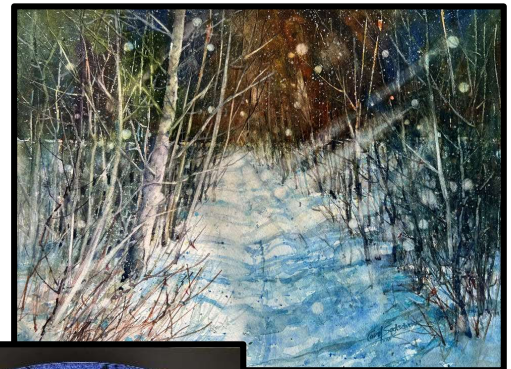

Participants will explore three different paint pouring techniques. Learn everything you need to know to get started, from paint and prep-work to composition and clean-up. Cost: \$50 per person includes all supplies for three paintings.

### Optional but Recommended:

- 1) Wear old clothes (including shoes!) and/or bring an apron.
- 2) Acrylics dry fast, but fluids can take longer. To bring your wet artwork home bring a large disposable aluminum tray or cardboard box for the car.
