Materials/Supply List for Intermediate ACRYLICS Painting Class

This Material list is for the MINIMUM supplies needed to take this course:

Panel or canvas to paint on:

(2) Square "Primed" Panels at least 16" x 16" hardboard primed smooth surface panels (1/8 or 1/4" Masonite) larger square panel like 18"x18" is a great size!

**Can substitute economy canvas panels of same size – due to the Surface texture of these panels, details will be more difficult to achieve.

**you can also use a stretched canvas-small weave to achieve details

Paints: Professional (not student grade) heavy body acrylic tube paint 2 oz. tubes: Yellow, Orange, Red, Purple, light green, dark green, dark blue, light blue, dark brown, light Brown, Black, White

Not less than 22ml/.74 US Fluid Oz., 59ML/2 US Fluid OZ Preferred

Brushes: buy a set of brushes for best value!

** like Princeton series 3750 natural and synthetic Brushes

(all short handle)

Minimum needed:

Script Liner or Liner size 1

Short Liner (for fine lines) size 10/0 or 2/0

Fan Brush size 1 and 2

Filbert size 2 and/or 4

Dagger Striper 1/4" and 3/8"

Scrubber size 2 and/or round hog hair/bristle brush size 2 or 3

Flat size 4 and 6 that come to sharp edge
Palette knife (for newer users the assorted plastic knife set is fine)
** if you can't get all the brushes above, please get as many as you can to
make creating details the easiest

Palette (wet) a palette with a tight sealing cover is best for acrylics.

** one my favorites is the Blick Covered Palette (item# 03036-1002) .

**You can also find easily available is a "Masterson Sta-Wet Palette Seal"
which comes with a tight lid/seal

Disposable Palette (if not using a wet palette) Pad of palette paper 8x10 paper or
larger or Styrofoam plates (great for mixing then disposable)

Spray Mist bottle - small (for spraying the acrylics, to keep moist) like Blicks item #
08977-1003 or Holbein Water color Atomizer Bottle -Blick# 02912-1003

Additional: handheld hair dryer

Roll of paper towels

Small pointed Palette knife for mixing small batches of colors

Pencil

Paper or note pad for taking notes
