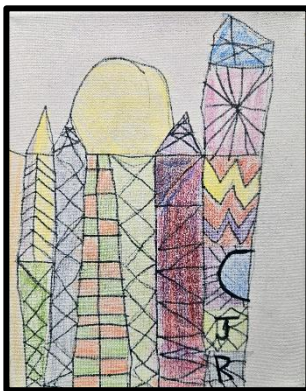
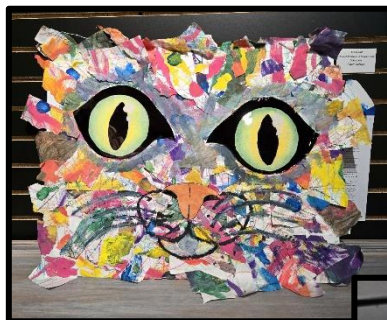

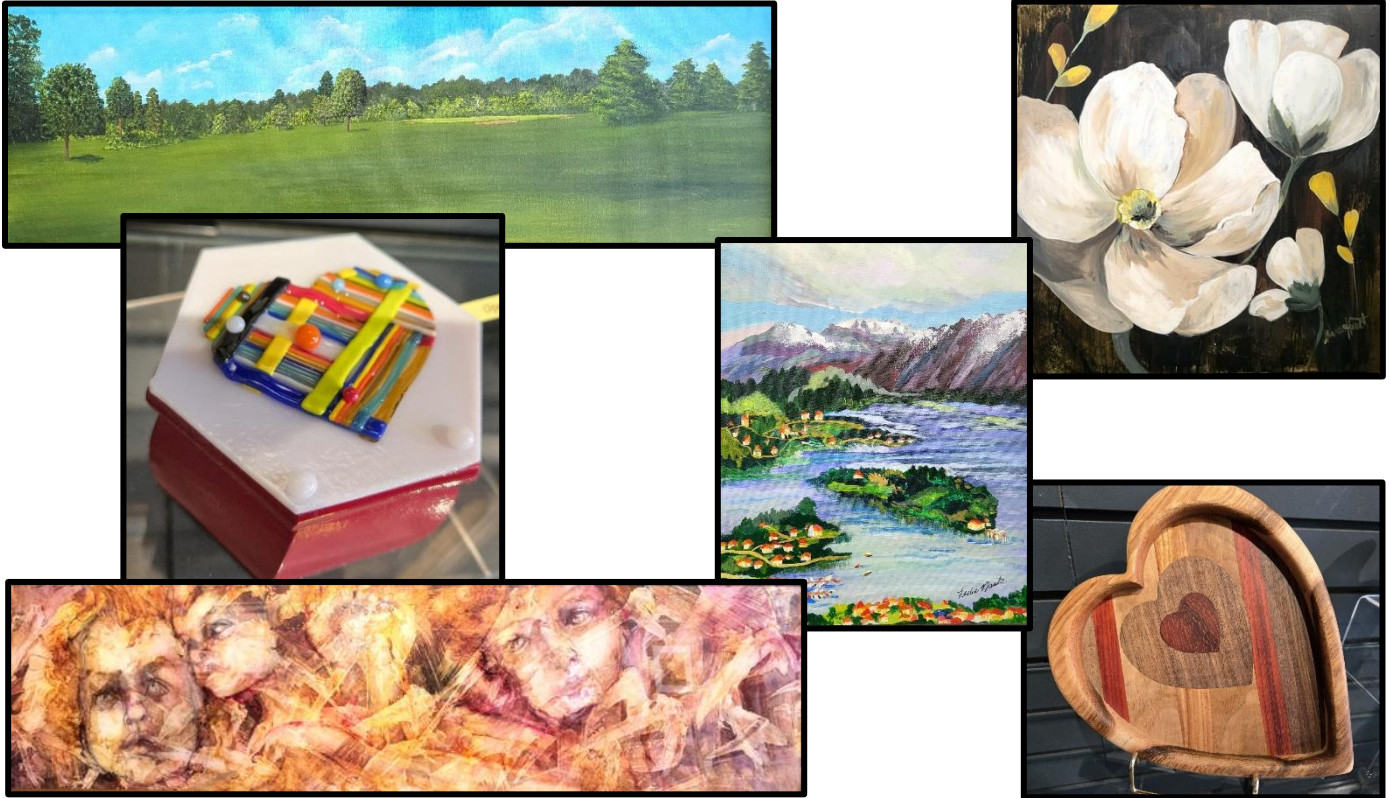

FEATURED ARTIST: Ciara Hammond

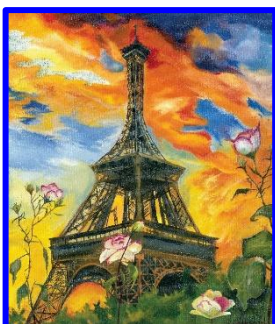

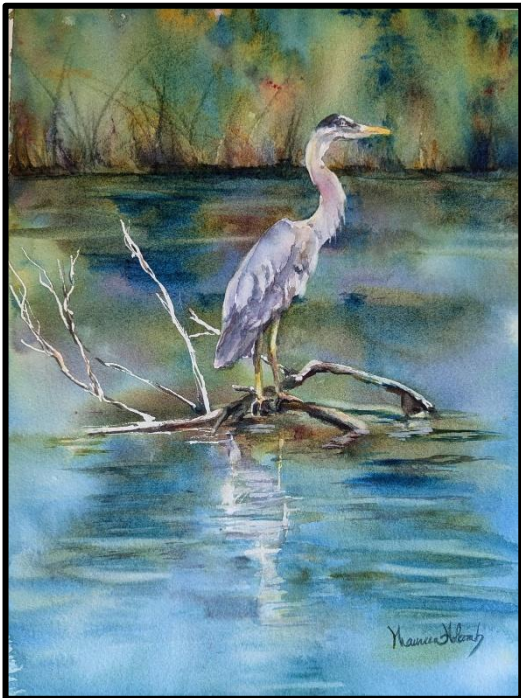

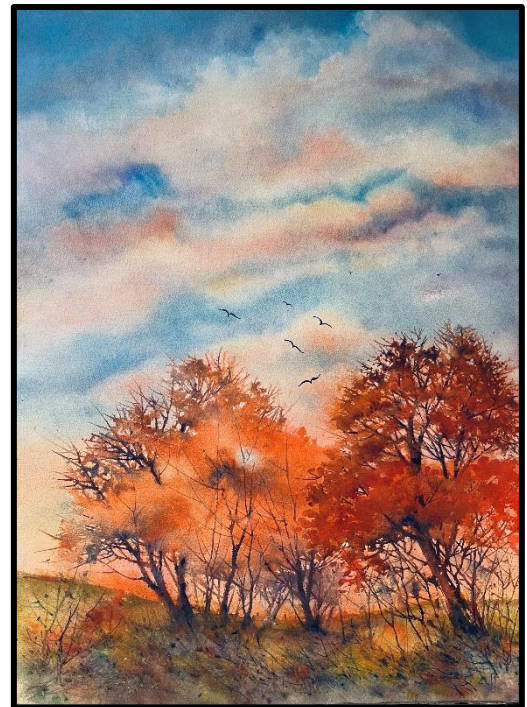
Other Art News
